

Continue your alumnae membership.

After your free 1½-year membership has expired, there are three membership options.

Life Member – For a one-time fee, you are entitled to receive the Candle Beam and all other informational mailings for the rest of your life. It also gives you the opportunity to be seated as a Life Member delegate at Kora or National Conferences. This cost is currently \$250 (or \$225 if you choose to receive the Candle Beam electronically) and can be paid in installments.

Member-at-Large (MAL) – For a yearly fee you are entitled to receive the Candle Beam and all other informational mailings for the year in which MAL dues are paid. It also gives you the opportunity to be seated as a Member-at-Large delegate at Kora or National Conferences. This cost is currently \$20.

Alumnae Chapter Member – Dues for this membership vary from chapter to chapter, but a portion of the dues go to the national organization and a portion helps support the local alumnae chapter. Alumnae Chapters meet for activities and service projects.
