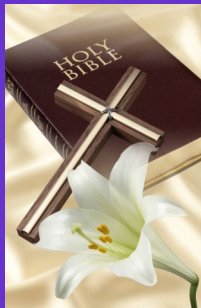

The tribe they are associated with is Cherokee and their Pastor is Dan (Fire Crow) Lybarger. The

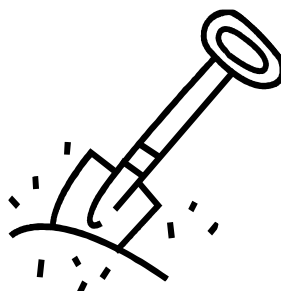


NAF Dayspring Church is a United Methodist denomination. Those who attend do not have to be Native American, although the services focus on Native American customs.
